<u>Summary</u>

Background

Council will be aware that this topic was raised in November 2012 where it was resolved

"That the Council advise the Chairman of the Goldfields – Esperance Tourism Alliance that the Shire of Dundas supports the concept of becoming an RV friendly region however will not provide overnight or longer term parking areas within the Norseman town site to accommodate self-contained recreational vehicles."

It was further proposed at the September 2014 meeting "that the Shire of Dundas determine an appropriate area within the Norseman town site that meets the requirements of parking for self- contained RV vehicles that will allow Norseman to become a RV friendly town"

An alternative proposal was moved resolving that "the surrounds of the Norseman oval be utilised as a 24 – 48 hour rest area for self-contained RV vehicles for a 12 month period".(Cr JEP Hogan requested that his name be recorded as voting against the motion).

It has now become evident that parking on the oval is bringing its own problems of hygiene, security of shire assets, extended stays to mention a few. The biggest problem to our community is that community members are no longer comfortable walking around the oval due to the presence of the caravans.

There is an alternative site available which would be very suitable for the RV vans and by relocating the vans would save the oval for community use.

The proposed area is south of the Tin Dam, at the junction of Ramsay and Brockman Streets. Although there is a culvert running through a portion of this area it would be a simple task to divert traffic from this potential hazard. There are no electric cables on the site nor are there ablution facilities.
