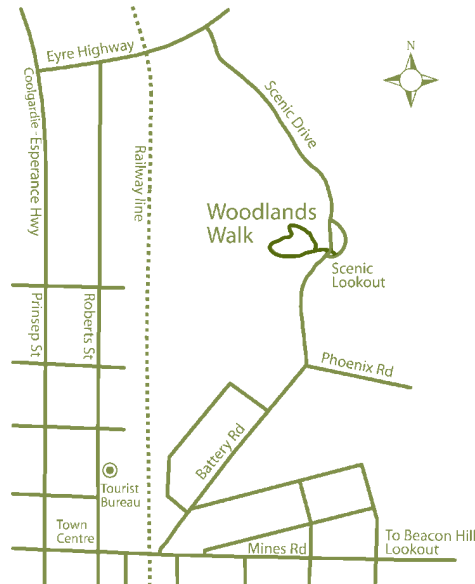


The Woodlands Walk has been designed as a window to this world, a means of understanding some of what makes this landscape such a unique and special place. The Walk is short - not even a kilometre in length - and provides an easy 30 to 40 minute opportunity to look at and learn about the woodlands.



The 13 interpretive panels along the route not only give a 'European' perspective of selected natural features of the woodlands, but also provide an insight into relevant aspects of the local Ngadju culture.
