The Annual Meeting of Electors is held once every financial year for the purpose of discussing the annual report and any other general business.



The Agenda allows for:

Discussion about contents of annual report for the previous financial year;



Update on decisions from previous Annual Meeting of Electors; and



General business (including motions to be voted on by the electors of the Shire).



Who can participate?

Electors' meetings are open to all members of the public, however, only electors may move, second, speak to and vote on motions. Residents can check to see if they are on the electoral roll through the Western Australian Electoral Commission website.
